This Sunday, June 2nd, is the great feast of The Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). In addition to our regular schedule of Masses on Saturday and Sunday, we will also have an afternoon of Eucharistic devotion at the Canal Winchester High School Cafeterium on Sunday. Pledges Now Top
\$813,000

Here's the latest information about the Fund Drive:

- 87 percent of the pledge cards have been turned in
- \$813,902 pledged
- 237 donors have been recorded, which is 78.7% participation
- \$3,434 average pledge

There are still about 40 households who have not yet responded. A follow-up mailing is scheduled to be sent this week to those 40 households. Again, we invite everyone to participate in this worthwhile parish program by making a pledge or one-time gift.

Because the first Building Fund payment envelope will not be available until the July packet arrives, we will send out a separate June payment envelope to everyone who has pledged. This will allow those who wish to make a payment in June to do so. Thanks to all who have helped make this campaign successful.

Starting next month (July), the church offertory envelopes will be sent on a monthly basis. Within this monthly packet of church envelopes will be a special envelope for building fund payments. It will be the envelope on top and will have our campaign theme of *Many Gifts – One Spirit* printed on the front. Anyone returning pledge payments by cash or check is asked to use this monthly envelope. Credit card deductions should also begin by June.
