WORDS OF OUR PATRON BLESSED JOHN XXIII

Respect for the opinion of others
Beware of misunderstandings: they arise, challenge each other, and come to blows. We must be on our guard against them; if they cannot be avoided, at least let us not cultivate them, or allow them to be exaggerated in our imagination. Let us try, unashamedly, to be the first to explain them away, to put things right once more, to disentangle them and to keep ourselves free from any feeling of resentment. Even among cultured and spiritual people, there may be a variety of opinions and views in matters open to discussion. This does no harm to charity and peace, as long as we preserve moderation of manner and harmony of minds. I will add moreover that the Lord makes use of these misunderstandings to bring about in other ways some great good. Thus Paul and Barnabas separated because of young John Mark... and yet they were both equally righteous and holy. With souls like these, everything is set right by the Lord's grace. But this does not alter the fact that we must beware of misunderstandings and must try to clear them away. We can never forget those words of our Lord's which so surprised the world, when He said that it gives more joy and peace to the heart to believe and to renounce than to demand and receive.
